	Turn off pool and deck lights, turn on ba	athhouse and office lights.
	Inspect all grounds: Fence, gates, safety equipment, handrails, ladders, deck, chairs, etc. Make sure	
	everything is safe, clean, and in good co	ndition.
	Pick up any trash and empty containers in the pool area.	
	Hose down pool deck; wash away from the pool.	
	Check drain cover to ensure it is attached and fully intact, not cracked or chipped.	
	Clean any debris from the pool.	
	Check inlet and outlet fittings.	
	Check walls for stains or algae; brush walls and bottom, scrub scum line.	
	Measure water temperature.	
	Vacuum pool. Clean vacuum. Clean hair and lint strainer.	
	Empty and clean skimmer basket(s) or gutters.	
	Perform water chemical tests*. Record r	esults on Swimming Pool Report.
	☐ Free chlorine should be between 2.0 and 4.0 ppm	
	☐ pH should be between 7.4 and 7.6 ppm	
	Check chemical reservoir level.	
	Check flow rate, pump pressure, and vacuum gauge readings.	
	Backwash filters if gauge pressure is 8 to 10 lbs. above normal pressure.	
	Check for leaks in the pump room.	
	Check pool water	Straighten or stow deck furniture.
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	Check water level to ensure optimal skin	nming
